






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Dear friends.

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CROSS-BORDER COOPERATION PROGRAMME

Cross-border programme between Bulgaria - the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia is financed by the "European Territorial Cooperation" objective through the Instrument for Pre-accession assistance (IPA) and co-financed by the state budgets of both partnering countries. The total budget of the Programme for the period 2007 - 2013 is 19 944 697 Euro, and 17 950 228 Euro are used for financing projects under a single set of rules and common approach based on mutual benefit for participants from both sides of the border. Thus the Instrument for Pre-accession assistance encourages cooperation, economic integration and convergence between the EU and candidate countries.

Bulgaria - the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia IPA Cross-border Programme for the period 2007 - 2013 was prepared as a result of coordinated efforts of relevant national institutions and a wide range of stakeholders at local, regional and national level, and was approved by the European Commission on 14 December 2007.

The eligible area of the Programme covers a territory of 18 736 sq. km with total population of 1 065 605 people. The overall borderline length is 165 km.

The border area of Bulgaria comprises the districts of Blagoevgrad and Kyustendil (NUTS III), covering 9 501 sq. km (8.6% of the total country territory) and with population of 486 291 people (6.3% of the total country population). It consists of 23 municipalities (NUTS IV) and 462 settlements:

- District of Blagoevgrad: 14 municipalities Bansko, Belica, Blagoevgrad, Gotce Delchev, Garmen, Kresna, Petrich, Razlog, Sandanski, Satovcha, Simitli, Strumiani, Hadjidimovo, Yakoruda;
- District of Kyustendil: 9 municipalities Bobovdol, Boboshevo, Dupnitza, Kocherinovo, Kyustendil, Nevestino, Rila, Sapareva Banya, Trekliano.


The border area of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia comprises the North-East, the East and the South-East NUTS III sta-

tistical regions covering 9 235 sq. km (35,9 % of the total country territory) and with population of 579 314 people (28.6 % of the total country population). It consists of 27 municipalities (NUTS IV), including 641 settlements:

- North-East region: 6 municipalities Kratovo, Kriva Palanka, Rankovce, Kumanovo, Lipkovo and Staro Nagoricane;
- East region: 11 municipalities Berovo, Pehcevo, Vinica, Kocani, Cesinovo - Oblesevo, Zrnovci, Probistip, Stip, Karbinci, Delcevo, Makedonska Kamenica:
- South-East region: 10 municipalities Valandovo, Gevgelija, Bogdanci, Dojran, Radovis, Konce, Strumica, Bosilovo, Vasilevo and Novo Selo.

Technical assistance goal is to ensure effective programme management and information flow in order to be achieved the programme objectives.



RESULTS

During this programming period 2007 - 2013, the Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance brought new challenges to the management structures and to the project beneficiaries, who had to change-over to the new criteria for shared management and joint actions. The implementing structures and the management and control system established for the purpose of the current programme are fully operational with the necessary capacity.

Three open calls for proposals were launched under the period 2007-2013 which attracted a total of 310 applications. This figure is a positive sign for the dynamics of the bilateral collaboration between the two neighbouring countries and show intensity of cooperation at stage of preparation of project proposals. At the same time, the big number of common project proposals demonstrates good will and increased interest in launching common cross-border initiatives contributing to the sustainable development of the region.

As a result of selection procedures, contracts for implementation of 98 projects were signed, each involving 2 or more project partners from both countries. These projects are jointly implemented by 223 entities (municipalities, district administrations, non-profit organisations, cultural and educational institutions, etc.) The financed projects cover variety of thematic issues including improving small-scale public infrastructure, protecting the environment, investing in education and knowledge sharing, strengthening research and innovation, enhancing cultural exchange, promoting local and regional governance, etc. Projects under the programme are relatively small in budget but create valuable cross-border partnership, influence territorial cohesion, contribute for sharing the European values and integration.










BENEFICIARIES

Variety of regional and local entities (municipalities, district administrations, NGO's, cultural and educational institutions, associations and business support organizations, etc.) had directly benefited by the IPA Cross-border Programme through participation in projects.

Citizens and governments of the two countries also benefitted from the results of the Programme. Indirectly, the inhabitants of the cross-border region benefited from the Programme through the direct investments in the region and the joint use of infrastructure, enhanced cooperation activities in sectors as culture, tourism and education.

The Programme contributes also for the progressive alignment of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia with the standards and policies of the European Union with a view to the forthcoming membership. As regards the direct advantages for the partnering candidate-country (in light of EU accession), the Programme facilitates the transition to the EU practices on a multi-level basis (becoming more familiar with the use of the instruments in place for implementing mainstream EU interventions, the transfer of knowhow between Programme implementing structures, etc.).

The project aims at creating sustainable environment to attract the young people to stay and live in the cross border region. Old unused municipal buildings were reconstructed into Youth Training Centers and Labor Market Analysis (LMA). As a result of 40 youth from municipalities of Staro Nagorichane and Rila had passed Job Related Training and received retraining Certificate. Several companies from the municipalities singed Letter of Confirmation and accept retrained youth on practice with potential of permanent employment. Also, two Y4Y NGOs were established as future manager organizations of the Training centers.

These old people need professional rehabilitation and contacts with each other to overcome isolation were included in everyday life of the community. Children with special needs that cannot be fulfilled in a regular kindergarten as a result of the project were included in the education system. Established centres contribute to social inclusion of those disadvantaged groups as for the exchange of knowledge between professionals in the social sphere of the border region.
