

THE PROGRAMME

The **overall objective of the Programme** is to intensify cross-border cooperation between both partnering countries in order to jointly address common challenges and exploit untapped potentials of the border regions.

Programme Budget

The total Programme budget is EUR 19 461 690.

The Programme is co-funded by the European Union, from the Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance II (IPA II).


Basics facts about the Second Call for project proposals

SECOND CALL FOR PROPOSALS - IMPLEMENTATION

In total 20 project proposals were contracted on total amount of 4 724 181,94 EUR, out of which: 17 subsidy contracts were concluded in 2019, 3 more contracts from reserve list were signed in 2020. On the beginning of 2021, from the reserve list, 5 subsidy contracts with projects will be signed. The list of all projects approved for financing is uploaded on the Programme's website in section Funded projects.




EVENTS ORGANISED IN 2020


At the end of the session, the movie with a presentation of our Programme realized and broadcast during the celebration of EC Day and 30 years of Interreg was shown.

Online training for the Bulgarian management team members of projects funded under the Second call for project proposals - reserve list was held on the 16th of July 2020 under platform Zoom. In the presence of members of the Bulgarian project management team, representatives of the Joint Secretariat and the Managing Authority elaborated the tech-





nical and financial project implementation, monitoring, contracting procedures, verification of expenditure by controllers, communication and visibility, electronic system for exchange of documents and information, irregularities and other relevant issues.




NEW PROGRAMME PERIOD 2021—2027

The Joint Working Group of INTERREG-IPA Cross-border Cooperation Programme between Republic of Bulgaria and Republic of North Macedonia 2021-2027 on 13th of July 2020 adopted the Territorial analysis for Republic of Bulgaria and Republic of North Macedonia Cross-border Area including SWOT analysis and conclusions. On 27th of October 2020, the Joint Working Group adopted the Programme's Intervention logic by a Written procedure.



In the framework of the preparations for the new programming period 2021-2027, the discussion on the selection of the program overall objectiv continued. Formal and informal consultations related to the selection of the strategic project Establishment of new Border cross check point "Klepalo" between Republic of Bulgaria and Republic of North Macedonia also continued.






PROGRAMME WEBSITE AND SOCIAL MEDIA PAGES




PROGRAMME MEDIA CAMPAIGN AND MEDIA COVERAGE

Two media campaigns were organized: campaign for Training seminar for Programme beneficiaries under Second Call for project proposals and campaign for European Cooperation Day 2020 / 30 years INTERREG.

Over 90 different publications related to Programme activities were spreaded among general public through electronic and printed media of both countries (web portals, local, regional and national newspapers, TV and radio stations).
