

THE PROGRAMME

The **overall objective of the Programme** is to intensify cross-border cooperation between both partnering countries in order to jointly address common challenges and exploit untapped potentials of the border regions.

Programme Budget

The total Programme budget is **EUR 19 461 690**.

The Programme is co-funded by the European Union, from the Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance II (IPA II).

Programme area

The 5 NUTS III or equivalent regions involved in Programme area in Bulgaria: Districts of Blagoevgrad and Kyustendil and in North Macedonia: North East, South East and East regions.



Distribution of project by Specific Objectives




- The progress of implementation for the projects was promoted through electronic media, social media, as well as on numerous websites a focused on all aspects for the implementation of projects.








Online training for the project management team members

Online training for the Macedonian management team members of projects funded under the Second call for project proposals - reserve list was held on the 17th and 18th March 2021 under platform Zoom. In the presence of 18 members of the project management team, representatives of the National Authority, First Level Control and Joint Secretariat elaborated the technical and financial project implementation, monitoring, communication and visibility, contracting procedures, electronic system for ex-





change of documents and information, verification of expenditure by controllers, irregularities and other relevant issues.

EUROPEAN COOPERATION DAY 2021



Our Program this year under the motto "Sharing borders, growing closer", realized online event "Virtual Tourist Fair". The aim was to present the Programme and the cultural heritage and the tourist opportunities of the cross-border region through recorded visits to certain places in the region and broadcasting of already produced videos that are a product of the realized projects. The video also included welcome speeches by the Deputy Minister of the Ministry of Regional Development and Public Works of the Republic of Bulgaria and by the Deputy Minister of the Ministry of Local Self Government of the Republic of North Macedonia.



The video was broadcast via the Program's Facebook and YouTube channels on 21st September 2021.

In the previous campaign and during the broadcast of the video, viewers were given the opportunity to interactively participate in the program by sending their video and photo materials and thus will have the opportunity to receive some of the promo materials related to this annual celebrating the 10th anniversary of European cooperation. The celebration of the European Cooperation Day 2021 attracted a relatively large and diverse audience of local citizens, including the media, and was praised by INTERACT as an event that attracted the most organic viewers.

NEW PROGRAMME PERIOD 2021—2027

Second meeting of the Joint Working Group

On 11th February 2021, the second meeting of the Joint Working Group for INTERREG - IPA Cross-border Cooperation Programme Bulgaria - North Macedonia 2021-2027 was held online. The meeting was chaired by Ms. Denitsa Nikolova, Deputy Minister of the Regional Development and Public Works of the Republic of Bulgaria and co-chaired by Mr. Zoran Dimitrovski, Deputy Minister of Local Self-government of the Republic of North Macedonia. Greetings were expressed by Ms. Klaudia Feurle, representative of the DG for Regional Policy and Urban Policy, European Commission. The main focus was the discussion and adoption of the Intervention Logic for the forthcoming Programme period 2021-2027.

Public consultations on a draft Territorial Strategy for Integrated Measures

Working meetings under campaign for collecting project ideas that will be implemented under the Territorial Strategy for Integrated Measures


In order to prepare the new Programme, Managing Authority organizes a working meeting on 9th November 2021 in Blagoevgrad with local authorities, NGOs, museums, community centers and civil society from Southwestern Bulgaria in connection with the launched Campaign to gather project ideas for implementation within the Integrated Territorial Strategy, which is part of the Programme. The priorities of the Program for the programming period 2021 - 2027 were presented at the meeting and clarifications were made to questions asked by local organizations.





The workshops for the presentation of the objectives of the campaign for collecting project ideas within the Integrated Territorial Strategy in the Republic of North Macedonia were held on line and hosted by the Ministry of Local Self Government and Joint Technical Secretariat in Strumica on 22th November (Northeast Planing Region), 24th November (East Planning Region - two sessions) and 25th November (Southeast Planning Region), with presence of more than 150 participants.



PROGRAMME MEDIA CAMPAIGN AND MEDIA COVERAGE
