

Presentation of project ideas for development of the cross-border region within the scope of the INTERREG IPA CBC programme between the Republic of Bulgaria and the Republic of North Macedonia 2021-2027

Dear partners,

In the next seven years the European Union will expand financing of projects that come from the local communities. This territorial approach, known as "bottom-up", is deeply embedded in the CBC programme between Republic of Bulgaria and Republic of North Macedonia 2021-2027, where half of the budget is streamed for such projects. Their implementation of the programme will be based on an Integrated Territorial Strategy of the CBC region (ITS). It aims to support the ideas of local entrepreneurs, institutions and organizations for integrated development of the territory, taking into account common challenges that both sides of the border face. The ITS support concentrates on two objectives: (1) Increasing the competitiveness and improving the business environment, and (2) Overcoming the seasonality of the tourism industry.

A very important aspect of the implementation of ITS is the need to build a strong link between funded projects and strategy's goals. In this regard, we invite you and your members to present project ideas and solutions that you believe can transform the cross-border region into a desired place for life and investments. When drawing your idea, you should take into account the following factors:

- The submission of a project idea at this stage does not guarantee the green light for funding;
- The deadline for signing of contracts under the programme is December 31, 2027.
- The indicative total budget of the ITS is EUR 13.7 million, divided in the following two thematic area/s:
 - ✓ Development of the competitiveness of the CBC area (technological modernization, updating of knowledge and skills (green and digital transition), product development and realization) 20% ITS's budget share;
 - ✓ Development of tourism industry in the CBC area (mobility, connectivity, small-scale infrastructure, new or improvement of existing year-round tourist products). The strategy does not set tourism sub-sector restrictions) 80% ITS's budget share.

A critical component of your project idea is the need to build it on a broad partnership with local organizations from either side of the border and to emphasize on clearly measurable cross-border benefits and effects.

The submitted project ideas will be used as a basis to set up a list of operations (thematically grouped project ideas) that will underpin the implementation of the ITS. Here are the criteria by which the received project ideas will be thematically analyzed/grouped in operations:

- Cross-border effect of the project idea, achieved as a result of a broad and multi-sectoral partnership;
- Clear links of the project idea with the objectives and measures set in the Strategy;



- Correspondence between the resources needed and the time and budget framework of the Strategy

There will be workshops organized in each of the programme regions where interested enterprises, organizations and all types of institutions may take part and receive answers of all questions they may have in relation to the present campaign for collecting project ideas. Gathering all CBC actors in one place can spur and unlock strong motivation and inspiration to set up an active community that really makes a difference on the cross-border region.

Participation in the workshops needs to be confirmed. Each workshop is expected to be no more than 2 hours.

The workshops in the Republic of Bulgaria will be held *online and hosted by the National Centre for Regional Development on November 17 and 18, 2021, 15:00 p.m.*

The workshops in the Republic of North Macedonia will be held *online and hosted by the Ministry of Local Self Government and Joint Technical Secretariat - IPA BG-MK - Antenna Strumitsa on* November 22, 24 and 25, 2021, 13:00 p.m.
